Frida Kahlo

*Mexican painter; * 1907 in Mexico City; † 1954 ibid.*

Tequila · lime juice · agave syrup · pomegranate juice · chilli flakes · lime slice

A fiery and vibrant cocktail that captures Kahlo's passionate and colourful art and personality.

Salvador Dalí

*Spanish painter, graphic artist, writer, sculptor and stage designer; * 1904; † - 1989 ibid.*

Tequila · lime juice · agave syrup · pomegranate juice · orange zest · thyme sprig

A creative and surreal cocktail that captures Dalí's eccentric and unmistakable style.

Claude Monet

*French painter; * 1840 in Paris; † 1926 in Giverny*

Gin · elderflower liqueur · lemon juice · sugar syrup · champagne · blue curacao · flowers · mint leaves

A floral, light and elegantly coloured cocktail, inspired by Monet's impressionist works and his garden in Giverny.

Ingo Lorenz

*German art photographer; * 1960 in Eppelsheim*

Vodka · elderflower liqueur · lemon juice · rose syrup · green tea · Angostura bitters · medium mineral water · cucumber slice · mint leaf · blossom

A versatile and harmonious cocktail that reflects the artist's unique style and the mix of reality and dream in your art.

Andy Warhol

*American photographer; * 1902 in San Francisco; † 1984 in Carmel-by-the-Sea*

Vodka · Blue Curacao · pineapple juice · cranberry juice · mineral water medium · pineapple slice

A pop and colourful cocktail inspired by Warhol's iconic and modern works.

David Hamilton

*British art photographer and filmmaker; * 1933 in London; † 2016 in Paris*

Gin · rose liqueur · lemon juice · sugar syrup · tonic water · rose petals · lemon slice

A light and floral cocktail that represents Hamilton's soft, romantic and dreamy photography.

Vincent van Gogh

*Dutch painter; * 1853 in Groot-Zundert; † 1890 in Auvers-sur-Oise*

Absinthe · lemon juice · sugar syrup · egg white · lemon peel · anise stars

A strong and complex cocktail with a hint of bitterness and elegance that reflects van Gogh's powerful and moving style.

Helmut Newton

*German-Australian photographer; * 1920 in Berlin; † 2004 in Los Angeles*

Cognac · Fernet Branca · sugar syrup · orange bitters · lemon zest

A strong and elegant cocktail that reflects Newton's provocative and glamorous photography.

Ansel Adams

*American photographer; * 1902 in San Francisco; † 1984 in Carmel-by-the-Sea*

Bourbon · maple syrup · Angostura bitters · orange peel · cherry

A powerful and natural cocktail that reflects Adams' love of nature and his monochrome photography.
